INTRODUCTION

This year Steer Foundation give more importance to Awareness programmes than projects. In these awareness programmes, the Foundation covered: Computer Education & Animation, School drop outs, Rural Health & Development, Art and Culture, Environment, HIV/AIDS, and Gender Sensitization Programmes. This year the Foundation managed all the projects without any grants and sponsors. With these two projects also successfully completed.

PROJECTS AND PROGRAMMES

Computer Literacy and Animation Programme for youths:

Steer Foundation conducted Computer Literacy & Animation programme for under privileged community youths of Malviya Nagar. These programmes were conducted from April 2007 to June 2007 with project staff. Around 120 youths utilized the opportunity to study the basics of the Computer



and realized the scope of Animation Field in future. This programme helped many youths, especially girls to get employment in different offices. The coming year also the Foundation will facilitate with the same.

Informal Education for School Drop Outs:

STEER Foundation provided Informal education to the children of poor and underprivileged community staying in slums and villages, not having schooling facilities or drop outs. Steer Foundation appointed five teachers for the same and started classes for them in their slums, namely Begumpur, Malviya Nagar and Hauzrani. The main aim of the programme was to help them to start/restart their formal education. This education programmes were started on June 2007 and ended at January 2008. Most of them stated their Formal Education. STEER Foundation has created good atmosphere in creative learning.





Steer also facilitate Awareness Creation Programmes related to the Child Labour. Team explained the laws and complication related to child labour cases to the villagers and factory workers. The Team found that, in Malviya Nagar the children are used to do

hazardous work like welding, gas cutting, painting etc.

Rural Development Programmes:

STEER Foundation facilitated Rural Development Programmes in different Subjects; such as Safe Drinking Water & Sanitation Programmes, Legal Awareness Programs, Water Shed Programmes, Waste Land Development Programmes and Mass Awareness Creation Programmes, conducted in different areas. Project team added outside resource for the better implementation of the Programmes.



Health Care Awareness Programmes:



STEER Foundation organized Health Care Programmes at Sonipat, Haryana on December 2007. In this three days programmes team gave more importance to the women and children. The medical team conducted health check up camps in the same areas. The team also facilitated mass

awareness creation on water borne diseases and need of sanitation in their villages.

In the middle of September the Project team also facilitated a HIV/AIDS Awareness Creation Programme at Sangam Vihar, Delhi. The targeted population was the MSMs. With the help of Volunteers the Team met around 500 men in this programme. This programme helped them to avoid many confusions related to infection and all.

Art & Culture:



The foundation organized an open painting competition on 15th October 2007. In this competition the Project team gave importance to the need of education for the better future. All the non-formal education students attended the programme and also participated in inaugural function. Foundation congratulates the educational project team for their commitments.

Women Empowerment Programmes:

Women empowerment programmes are conducted in different places. The project team gave high importance to Social Justice, Legal Awareness, Leadership Training, Gender Equalities, Health and Nutritional Practices, Harassments, etc. with the help of another NGO Progressive Women's Welfare Association of India, Foundation is planning to implement a vast project in the same subject to the next year.

This year also the foundation gave importance to Pro-Girl Child Campaign in villages. The gender sensitization programmes helped the villagers to ask their confusions related to this. After the programme many of them sited with the counselors for a confidential talks.

Foundation facilitated with vocational training for the youth and married women to find out employment opportunities. This two month programmes helped 216 participants to urge the skills. Many of them informed that the career orientation programme helped them to get a job.



Legal Awareness Programmes:

The Team conducted a Consumer Protection Camp on 3rd January at Khirki Village, Delhi to provide awareness related to the rights of the consumer. In this camp the resource person detailed about Consumer courts, formalities related to filing a case, about the Ignorance of law, and need of united movements etc. the resource person also briefed about the laws related to the women rights.

Environment Programmes:



Steer Organized Awareness Programme on Environmental Issues; such as Safe water and Sanitation, Save energy, Air pollutions, Factory waste and its management and Waste land management. The team

also gave a brief idea about the laws and amendments related to this and hoe they can manage and face this issues.
